Ballymun Social Regeneration Fund – 2023 Payments

A sum of €1,725,000 has been allocated to the Ballymun Social Regeneration Fund for 2023. This funding is to continue to support the process of social regeneration in the area. The social regeneration objectives for Ballymun are set out in Sustaining Regeneration – A Social Plan for Ballymun. Applications for the 2023 fund closed on December 16th 2022 and 21 applications in total were received. The total amount of funding applied for was €2,068,225, which is €343,225 over the allocated budget of €1.725m.

The Assessment Panel met on January 9th, 12th and 19th 2023 to consider each application/programme proposed under this fund to ensure that the criteria as stipulated was met, all supporting documentation was in order and the service provision outlined in the work plans is in line with the objectives as set out in Sustaining Regeneration – A Social Plan for Ballymun

No funding was allocated to 2 of the groups and the following 19 organisations/groups have been allocated funding for 2023 as outlined below:
