### Team Dublin Clean Up

The upcoming Team Dublin Clean-up has been scheduled for Saturday, 22nd April 22, to ensure consistency with National Spring Clean month. To maximize resource allocation, the clean-up will take place in a single day rather than over a week-long period. The Public Domain Team will liaise with all participating groups and provide any necessary resources at local level.

## Better Ballymun
