The criteria for the installation of speed ramps are:  -The road should have a straight run of approximately 200 metres The 85th percentile speed (speed exceeded by 15% of vehicles) should exceed the posted speed limit.  -Traffic volumes should exceed 60 vehicles per hour.  -There should be genuine road safety concerns based on accident statistics or observed road safety patterns or a written report from an Inspector of the local Garda Síochána.
