

Elizabeth Street Greening Update

From Mable Street towards Elizabeth Street



Dublin City Council Parks, Biodiversity and Landscape Department have progressed the plans for the greening of Elizabeth Street in Drumcondra, in conjunction with E&T department. The greening works will involve tree –build-outs on the southern side of the street, which will include SuDs tree pits, containing 7 no. new trees and pollination friendly planting schemes. These works will involve the removal of 11 no. paid parking spaces along the southern side of the street.

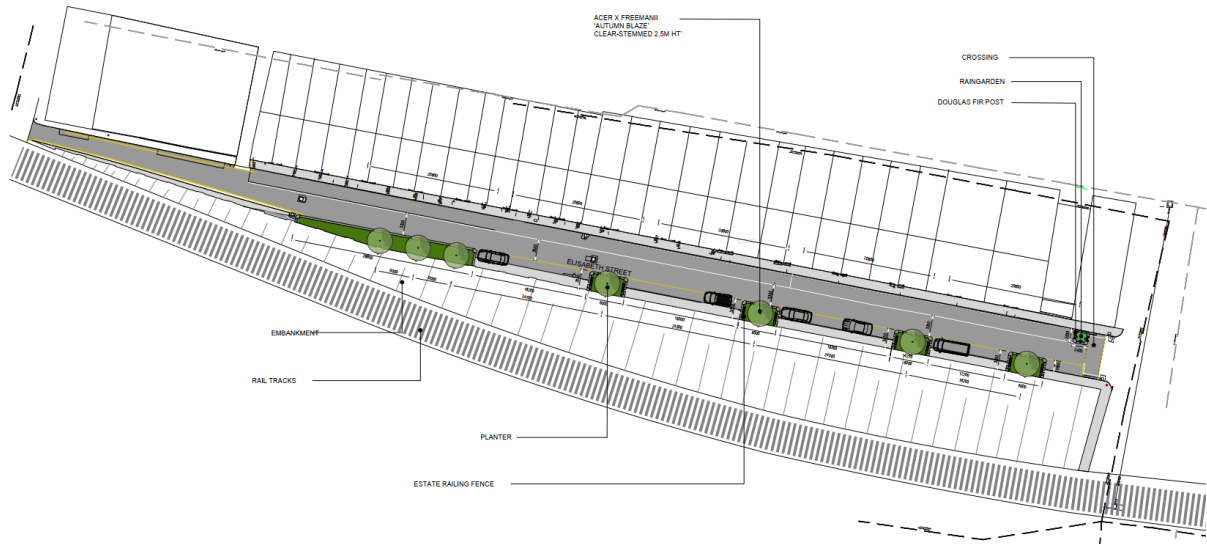
Following a public consultation held on the road with the residents of Elizabeth street on 19th July 2023 last, the following comments were noted;

Over 80% of Elizabeth Street households said that they would like trees to be planted on Elizabeth Street in response to a questionnaire in July 2020. This was the starting point of the project. No negative responses were received & 3 houses were unoccupied at the time.

Over a third of households either attended the on-street consultation on 19 July 2023 or made contact in support of the project in lieu of attending. All feedback has been positive and supportive. At least 3 houses are currently unoccupied.

There was a welcome for the plan and overall support for the layout/design for the planting.

This project will be delivered under the Landscape and Minor Works Framework, which is currently going through the procurement department. Once we are in a position to tender, we can expect work to commence with the intention of completing the scheme within the upcoming Spring 2024 planting season.
