Missing lifebuoy hampered efforts to save actor from drowning, inquest hears



Buoy toys: vandalism of safety floats rings up €50,000 cost

Dublin floats idea of tracker chip deterrent as young men on stag dos are blamed for theft and destruction of safety kit



Adding signage to lifebuoy brackets deters theft.


Local authorities across the country are spending more than €50,000 a year to replace an estimated 1,500 lifebuoys that are stolen or vandalised.

Dublin city council had to replace 500 lifebuoys in 2018 at a cost of €20,000. As the council is in charge of more than 140 lifebuoy locations, it is the equivalent
