




# Who can apply?

## Building Low Carbon Communities


- Not-for-profit organisation
  - Located in operational area of your county council
  - Registered with PPN
- or**
- Connected with other collectives e.g. The Wheel, Tidy Towns **and /or** a community group - Articles of Association or a constitution - hold an AGM, approved minutes available

### **NOT eligible for Strand 1:**

- Private individuals
- Commercial undertakings (including sole traders)
- Schools
- National community or environmental organisations
